- Opened on May 7, 1966
- Longest Tram in the Americas.
- Operates year round.
- The base elevation is 6,559. Peak elevation is 10,378, elevation climb is 3,819 feet, 2.7 miles and a 15 minute ride.
- Tower one: elevation of 7,010 feet and 232 feet tall. Tower One leans at an 18 degree angle towards the city.
- Tower two: elevation of 8,750 feet, and 80 feet tall.
- There are two track cables and one haul cable.
- On average the Tram makes 10,500 trips per year.
- Over 12 million people have been on the Tram.
